Sub: Submission of Material Inspection Call for RQM participation under tier-II of Quality Control Mechanism (QCM) under RGGVY - reg.

Sir/Madam,

The projects sanctioned under XI Plan (Phase- I & II) and XII Plan has to adhere 3-Tier Quality Control Mechanism to ensure better quality of materials. REC Quality Monitors (RQMs) under tier-II are responsible for conducting pre-dispatch inspection of major materials from the lot of materials jointly with TPIA & PIA. For this purpose, PIAs are advised to forward materials inspection call to REC, CO well in advance, so that RQM representative can be deputed for the joint inspection. However, we are unable to depute RQM to witness joint pre-dispatch materials inspection due to following reasons:-

1. Inspection call are generally received just before 1 or 2 days before date of inspection,
2. Fixed date & time of inspection is not mentioned in the call letter,
3. The name of RGGVY project is not provided by PIAs for which material inspection call has been raised,
4. Materials are not made ready & fake inspection calls were raised by turn-key contractors.

In order to conduct joint materials inspection properly by RQM, it is requested to provide following information while forwarding inspection calls:

1. The materials inspection calls be issued by PQCCs of PIA in prescribed format attached herewith at least 7 days in advance.
2. If a fake call is brought to notice then the contractor must be penalised @50,000/- per visit against deployment of quality monitor. Also, name of sub-vendor should be removed from the approved list of sub-vendors for RGGVY works.
3. A definite date is to be mentioned for inspection of the material in consultation with REC/TPIA/Turnkey Contractor & Manufacturer.
4. The material inspection call issued should have approved Guaranteed Technical Particulars & Manufacturing Quality Plan.

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5. Before, issuing dispatch clearance of materials, the scanned copy of joint inspection report duly signed by PIA, TPIA, Contractor & Manufacturer Engineer must be sent to REC through e-mail.
6. Material Inspection calls should be forwarded to REC by post along with a advance copy through e-mail on rggvycd@gmail.com and by fax on 011-24369850 to avoid postal delay.
